DO YOUR PART to Prevent Prescription Drug Abuse

The “**RED MED Box**” program is a partnership with local law enforcement agencies. People can dispose of prescription or over the counter pills, **INCLUDING** controlled substances like OxyContin, Vicodin, and Percocet- for Free!

- All pills accepted, loose or in plastic bags.
- Liquids accepted only if you first stuff a zip-lock plastic bag with enough paper towels to absorb all the liquid. Separate bags for each medication.
- **NO INHALERS OR SYRINGES**

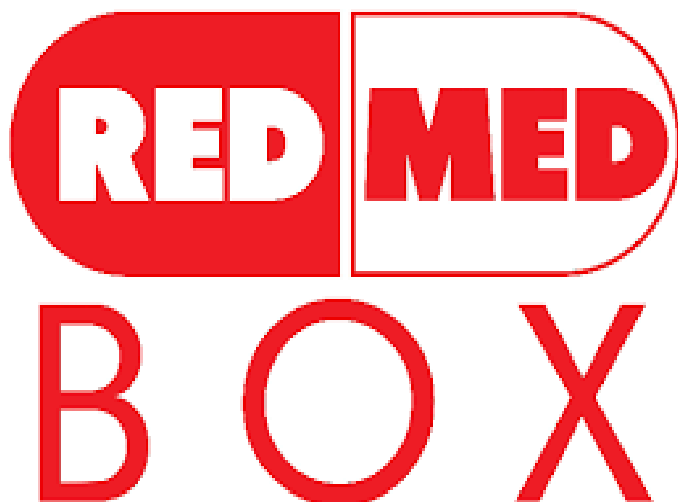
