

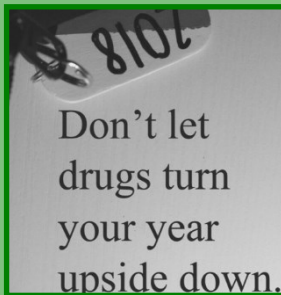
# Youth-Led Prevention Youth PhotoVoice—Pinckney

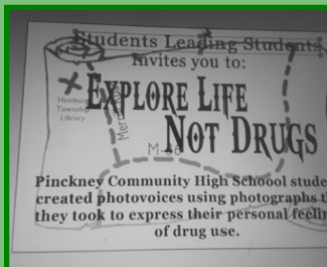
## What is Youth PhotoVoice?

Youth PhotoVoice is a process in which youth capture and record their thoughts and perceptions about a specific topic. It is used by groups who want their perspectives seen and heard by their community.

## “See What Our Youth Are Saying”

This year, PhotoVoice focused on all substances and the theme was “See What Our Youth Are Saying”. Our event was held on January 22, 2019 in the Pathfinder Commons; over 50 people attended, despite the season’s first record snowfall. Light desserts were served and our youth shined at the event.

## Youth PhotoVoice Outcomes

- 32 out of 38 surveyed attendees reported the photos and exhibit increased their awareness of youth substance use
- 34 out of 38 surveyed attendees reported they are likely or very likely to discuss the photos and exhibit with others
- 20 out of 38 surveyed attendees reported the photos and exhibit changed their beliefs about youth substance use
