Monroe County Student Prevention Leadership Teams (SPLT) complete an Annual Prescription Drug Initiative to educate their peers about the dangers of Prescription Drug Use.

8796 Monroe County High School and Middle School students surveyed identified at least one way to dispose of expired or unused prescription medications. 90% also knew where the six Monroe County Red Med Boxes are located for safe, quick and easy disposal.

91% Monroe County High School and Middle School Students surveyed Identified two ways opioids can affect brain chemistry.

899 Monroe County High School and Middle School students surveyed were able to identify at least 3 risks and consequences of prescription drug use.



Jefferson High School SPLT educated their peers on the importance of properly disposing of expired and unused medications and had them sign a pledge to stay drug free.
