Monroe High School "Stay off the Grass" initiative

95% Monroe County High School and Middle School Students surveyed recognized that it is not safe to drive under the influence of marijuana.

90% Monroe County High School and Middle School students surveyed acknowledged that marijuana is an addictive substance. 90% recognized the long term effects of marijuana use. Monroe County Student Prevention Leadership Teams run an Annual Marijuana Initiative to educate their peers about the dangers of Marijuana use.
